Volunteer Requirements

- Fingerprint clearance by NYCDOE
 - Registration in PETS (Personal Eligibility Tracking System)
 - Submission and clearance of fingerprints through IdenToGo services
- Knowledge of and skills with American Sign Language
- Over 18 years of age
- Availability from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm on school days
- Demonstrates ability to work in a calm, respectful and professional manner
- Willingness to work with a variety of students and staff and to follow instructions of staff
- Must follow SFDS' policies and procedure throughout the volunteer experience
- Proof of COVID vaccinations
